✓ **Direct Donor Program:**

Although there are many donor programs, most of them focus exclusively on sponsoring medical expenses. However, cancer patients, especially kids, need a lot more than just doctors and medicine. **A Single Light** goes a step further by directing donors who are willing to cover all other needs of a cancer patient including food, clothing, gas, and toys.

✓ **“Building Bridges”:**

A team of A Single Light volunteers will organize a wide range of community activities directed at informing people about living with cancer and living with someone afflicted by cancer. There will be a series of workshops, lectures, information meetings, and other community activities led by experienced psychologists, doctors, nurses, and social workers. The program will be directed at building understanding in the community and strengthening family ties.

✓ **“Our Survival Stories”:**

It helps to know that you are not alone. Our website will include a section consisting of personal stories from people who have won the battle against cancer, or who are currently going through the rehabilitation process. This will show to people struggling with the disease that someone else has suffered before them and succeeded. We hope that the section will become a great motivation for cancer patients not to give up the struggle.

✓ **Information Articles:**

Our website will include a collection of information articles covering a wide variety of topics from living with cancer to living around people affected by cancer. The articles will be updated on a regular basis. Our users will be able to read them from the website or to download them in PDF format. The articles will be written by health care professionals who are either on the board of directors of **A Single Light**, or who are our volunteers.

✓ **Discussion Board / Online journals:**

The discussion board on our website will help create an on-line community of people who are directly or indirectly affected by cancer. Our users will be able to share information in hope that others will find their stories or information beneficial. This will help distribute awareness about cancer in the community.
